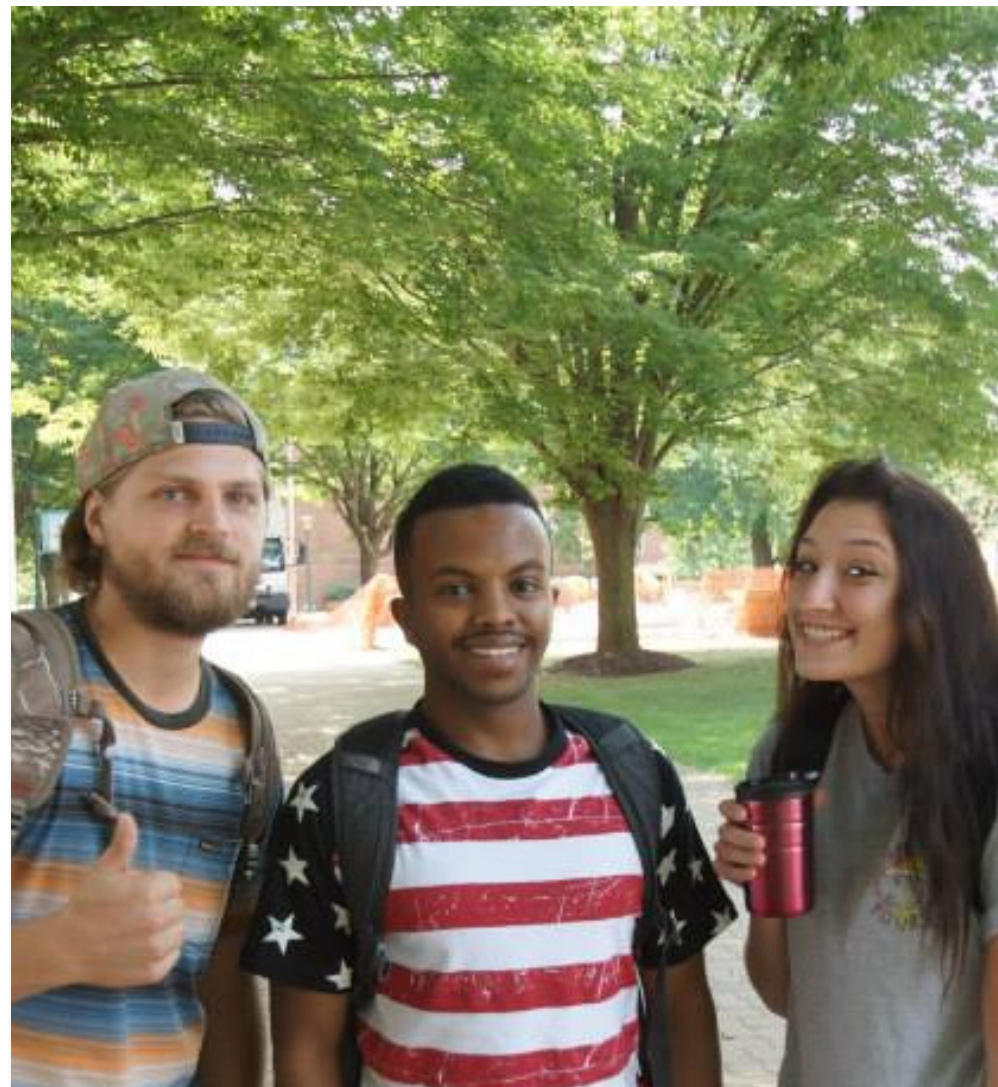


GAPP is bridging the gap to college access and affordability

Steps to Apply

1. Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and list all GAPP participating institutions you may attend
2. Create a Maryland State Aid Account through the Maryland Central Aid Processing System (MDCAPS) - <http://mdcaps.mhec.state.md.us>
3. Contact the financial aid office of the GAPP participating institution(s) and complete the institutional application for a matching GAPP award

HOW TO APPLY

Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Create a Maryland State Aid Account through the Maryland Central Aid Processing System. Contact the financial aid office of the GAPP participating institution.

AWARD AMOUNT

For the 2019-2020 academic year, the maximum annual Maryland GA grant is \$19,100. So, a student who is eligible for a maximum GA grant award of \$19,100 and a matching \$19,100 GAPP grant award would receive \$38,200 annually. Students who receive a GAPP award may still receive other forms of need-based and merit-based financial aid. These funds cannot exceed the cost of attendance at the institution you choose to attend.



WHO MAY APPLY

Eligible Maryland high school seniors who plan to attend a participating Maryland independent college or university as full-time, degree-seeking, undergraduate students.

ELIGIBLE MAJORS

All majors are eligible.

WHEN TO APPLY

For consideration, students must file the FAFSA by March 1. Verification documentation must be submitted by April 1.

RENEWING GAPP

A GAPP award may be renewed annually for three years for students who maintain eligibility.



GAPP ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Students must meet the income eligibility requirements for the Maryland GA and demonstrate eligibility for institutional need-based aid assistance. Students must also:

- be eligible for In-State tuition;
- have an unweighted cumulative high school GPA of 2.5 or higher;
- apply to a participating Maryland independent college or university as a full-time, degree-seeking, undergraduate student; and
- be under the age of 22 at the time of receiving the first award.
