SELLINGER MEANS:

MORE FOR **MARYLAND** LESS COST FOR TAXPAYERS



The State of Maryland has maintained a partnership with its private, nonprofit colleges and universities for over 230 years, beginning with the charters granted to Washington College in 1782 and St. John's College in 1784.

For more than two centuries, the State provided line-item appropriations for operating expenses, land, academic buildings, and equipment. State aid has been allocated through the Sellinger Program for the past 43 years, which awards grants to eligible independent colleges and universities through a formula linked to their enrollment and to the per-student appropriation at certain four-year public institutions.

Through the Sellinger Program the State provides modest grants to eligible, independent colleges and universities, which are used to support Maryland's goals for higher education as established in the State Plan for Postsecondary Education.

Today, Maryland's independent colleges and universities use the vast majority of the Sellinger funds (88%) to provide need-based grants and scholarships to Maryland residents. As a result, Marylanders have greater access, choice, and opportunities to enroll in college and pursue their dreams.




